Dear dr Shevel

My apologies for being quiet for so long. I trust that you are still well and that you cope with all the demands of your patients.

I am very busy at work as usual but try my best to prioritise and not to allow people to pressurise or upset me. As you know, that is not always possible.

I am very glad to say that I only had one migraine since the operation on 16 July 2008. That is totally amazing and I thank you and our Lord for that! I had to go for Voltaren injections (followed up with 2 Syndols) every week. (sometimes twice a week). The staff at the Catholic Hospital where I usually went for the injections, find it strange that they don't see me that often any more. I am just so grateful.

I must admit that I do get headaches occassionely (one or two per week) for which I use Norflex or sometimes if it is a tough one, Syndols. I am trying to only take one at a time. Most of the scars are healed now. My scalp is still a little bit sensitive, but now I can wash and blow my hair like in the past. I am a bit worried about the cut on top of my right eye. There is a little knob next to the cut. It seems to be sitting there for weeks already. Still a bit sore as well. The eyebrow however, is now almost perfect in shape. Remember, I told you the last time that it was a bit lower than the left one. I don't think that it is anything serious, but I just felt I should share with you.

Will keep you posted as we go along.

All the best. Take it easy in your work. (Remember to take a break every now and then - we still need you to be around for lots of years).

Thank you very much for everything that you did for me. Will be eternally grateful.
